Privy Explanation

The architectural style that best describes my privy is Mid-Century Modern. This design approach emphasizes clean lines, organic shapes, and an integration of function and form. My inspiration came from Den Outdoors, and while I drew from their concepts, I infused the structure with my own stylistic touches to make it unique and personal.

The privy features distinct Mid-Century elements, such as a rounded door and circular design motifs that give it a playful yet sophisticated appearance. The structure maintains a modern sensibility while standing out with a sense of individuality. The roof is subtly slanted, contributing to the sleek profile and visual interest of the design. It's finished in black wood with a matching flat black roof, flush with the walls on all sides, creating a clean, uninterrupted silhouette (often referred to as a parapet or concealed flat roof).

Inside, the space includes both a toilet and a sink, ensuring functionality. A circular skylight above allows natural light to flood in, echoing the rounded shapes that define the structure. On the upper back of the structure, above the toilet and sink, a lunette adds a soft architectural accent and additional daylight. The result is a modern, thoughtfully designed privy that merges practicality with style in a way that reflects both Mid-Century Modern ideals and my own creative vision.
